He has been a Research Fellow & Project Manager in ETRI for 30 years, to have developed the technology and standards for smart platform, IoT systems, mobile communication system, broadband network, and multimedia & encryption devices. Currently he is working for the department of Hyper-connectivity technology development.

For IoT, he has published two standards documents in ITU-T in Focus Group M2M (Machine to Machine) and Focus Group SWM (Smart Water Management) respectively, and been working as chairs for international IoT standards development groups. He is currently a rapporteur and editor of WI “adaptation of oneM2M for smart city” and WI “trust management in oneM2M” in oneM2M.

For Smart water management, he has been working with smart water sector in Korea since 2014, serving the Korean SWG society as a member of BoD, and the lecturer and organizing committee (Korean) of HIC2016. He has led MF4.4 in 7th World Water Forum as the moderator, chaired the Special Session in SWGIC2014, and contributed many water-related events as a chair and/or invited speaker.

He completed Ph.D course in SungKyunKwan University in Korea, for Information Engineering in 2001, and after then most of his experience has been focused on the international standardization activities in ITU-T, 3GPP, 3GPP2, TISPAN, ETSI M2M, ISO/IEC JTC1 SC27, & oneM2M, having taken many chair positions.
